The abstract (both paper and poster) should be submitted by 25th November 2017

- Abstract and full paper must be composed in MS word, Times New Roman font, size 12, line spacing 1.5
- Abstract should not exceed 250 words
- Full paper should not exceed 3000 words
- The presenters are requested to send the full papers both soft and hard copy on or before 1st December 2017
- Best presentations of both paper and poster category would be awarded with cash prize
- The selected papers will be published with ISBN.

Poster Presentation

- Area of the poster should be 3ft x 2 ft and printed without the name of authors.
- Only biodegradable materials should be used
- Numbers will be allotted to the presenters.
