The reworked papers should be sent to the

Some of the minor changes are:

Communication Skills had to include the
phonetics module.

Reading Kit - Essays by Bacon, Presely and
Lynd are to be removed and Lamb, A.C.

Gardner and Nehru are to be included.

Reflections on Indian Polity - The preamble
is to be removed and Ambedkar is to
be introduced

Reading Prose - In module 2 Swift and
Steele are to be introduced. Wole Soyinka's
Nobel Prize Speech is to be included.

The Order has to be rearranged.

Reading Poetry - In Module 3 include

Yeats, Easter 1916. Both Heaney and
Atwood were removed. Robert Keatsch
was retained and Buckley removed.

Reading Fiction - In module 1 Wells is
removed and Dickens' David Copperfield
is added. Both Poe and Kafka were
removed.

Reading Drama. 1 hour drama is to be cut to 4 plays

Language and Linguistics. Module one is phonetics, module 2 is linguistics

Literary Criticism is the same only the order has changed

Post Colonial Literatures - Chinua Achebe's *Things Fall Apart* is retained

Women's Lit. Toni Morrison is removed + Elaine Showalter is introduced. Both Spivak and Jasbir Jain are removed and Susie Tharu is added.

Indian Writing in English - C. V. Raman and Abbas is included and the play *Mukta Dharma* - Comparative Literature is henceforth including Culture Studies too.

The Board of Studies meeting began at 2pm after a silent prayer. This was followed by welcoming the Board members. The Board members approved the Minutes of the BOS meeting held on 17th Aug 2017. The panel of the list of Bilingual examiners and Question Paper setters was passed and approved.

The dept has decided to follow the recommendations in the syllabus suggested at the BOS meeting held on Aug 17, 2017.

Alongside this, we will be adhering to the revised M.C. University syllabus of Nov 2017 for Fine-Tune Your English (Common Course) and all other Common Course Papers according to M.C.U. In the Common Course, retaining the classics we are retaining Merchant of Venice alongside, Romeo & Juliet (The Balcony Scene) and retaining Module 3 as such (i.e. Les Misérables, & The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn Part-I). In the paper Hemispheric of Prose we are retaining Pico Tyer and not adding Vijay Nambisan's essay. In the Choice Based Course we have introduced Writing For Media which has been reduced to the stipulated hours (72). Module I which comprises, the introduction, has been removed & also the section on Films. We have added and incorporated Advertising which is an essential component. There was a suggestion to make digital media and advertising, assignments based. In the Core Course American Lit, there was a

- suggestion to add Levestov's "Alienation in Sullivan Valley" from her collection "This Great Unknown" and Paula Gunn Allen's "Grandmothers". Marianne Moore's "Poetry" will be deleted.
4. There was a felt need to incorporate relevant texts as background reading material for students. At this juncture, the course and feedback was also discussed.
 5. It was suggested that we can use technology in the evaluation methods. One of the suggestions made - there are a series of objective questions generated from a question bank list and corrections are automatically done (i.e. system generated).
 6. The next Board of Studies meeting was discussed.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Terry Anthony & Changes added in consultation with Dr. Beena Job & Harmony of Prose was a 5 module paper for 90 hours. Module 4 has been removed to convert the paper into a 72 hours (paper). Initially Modes of Fiction was a paper of 90 hours. The number of stories in Module I has been removed to make the paper a 72 hours paper. A note was added to the syllabus by Dr. Dalha - The assignment marks for the ^{Writing for Media} ~~Course~~ will be based on and subject to the successful completion of an on-the-job training at a advertising agency. The training must be for a period of 7 days & is aimed at providing students with a practical understanding of the work carried in an advertising agency and its various depts, especially the creative dept.
