












1-2015 MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF HOME SCIENCE AND ~~MANAGEMENT~~
~~STANDARDS~~ ST. TEREZIA'S COLLEGE, ERNAKULAM
(AUTONOMOUS)

The members of the Board of Studies of the Department of Home Science and ~~Business Studies~~ met on 31.1.2015 at 9.30 am in the Reading room, St. Teresa's College, Ernakulam. As regards the paper 'Women Entrepreneurship' a suggestion was made to change it to 'women empowerment' and modules suggested status, rights, law and procedure to be an entrepreneurship. It was also decided to conduct practicals only in even semester. Not much changes were suggested for the papers related to Interior decoration and family resource management. As regards Human Physiology and Microbiology suggestions were made to include FSSAI, food science - merging of modules along with inclusion of fats, sugar, units and alloys. Exclusion of bioavailability of nutrients was suggested for Human nutrition and biochemistry. Inclusion of regulation of blood glucose level, urinary calculi and assessment of nutritional status was suggested for Clinical nutrition and dietetics.

For Textiles, manufacturing processes of fabrics needs to be included. Weaves could be cut short and basic concepts for non weaves could be added. The practical paper for Extension should be cut short and revised it was suggested to include microbiology practicals. With regard to paper titled Child Development and Psychology, it was decided to divide the paper into three phases such as prenatal, post natal and preschool years. It was suggested that a paper on Adolescence ^{Development} would be more appropriate than offering General Psychology.

It was also suggested that the nomenclature of the programme could be changed from B.Sc

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 9.8.2017 was approved. As per the instructions given by syllabus revision committee of St. Teresa's College (Autonomous), there should not be substantial changes from the Mahatma Gandhi University syllabus. Within the prescribed limits, the following changes were made in the N.G. University syllabus (2017)

1) Title of the programme

The regular programme sanctioned in 1958 was B.Sc Home Science. As per Order No. 1038 B7/2016/Academic dated 21.2.2017, Mahatma Gandhi University has approved the scheme and syllabus of Bachelor's Programme in Home Science (Sl. No. 79). The revised model curriculum of UGC 2015 also retains the title as B.Sc Home Science. As per Order No. 584/ Acad/2/Hsc/2016 dated 31.01.2017, it was suggested that even if the name is Family and Community Science, the name Home Science should be retained in brackets. So, the BOS has decided to continue with the name of the programme as B.Sc Home Science.

2) Credits - Regarding Practical exam

As per Mahatma Gandhi University syllabus, credits have been assigned for practical courses in all semesters. But since St. Teresa's College (Autonomous) conducts practical exams only in the even semesters, credits for practicals are assigned only during even semesters. The list of practical courses have been changed correspondingly.

3) Inclusion of 'Environmental Studies and Home

has Family Resource Management as a component. In the BOS meeting, held on 9.8.2017, it was decided to combine Environmental Studies with Extension Education Course retaining Family Resource Management as a Core paper. The title of the Course is 'Environmental Communication and Human Rights' which has 4 credits.

PG Diploma Programme in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics:

- In PG Diploma syllabus, BOS approved course codes included for internships and project.
- Specific mark distributions were given for elective courses and community programme.

B.Voc Food Processing Technology

- Included Environmental studies in the V semester as general components in the place of Computer Applications.
- The contents of Computer Applications were included in 'Product and Brand Management' course of V semester.

Diploma in Health Care Assistance

The Board of Management held on 11.1.2018 suggested modifications in syllabus and examination pattern which has to be approved by National Skill Development Corporation - Health Sector Skill Council before implementation. The modified syllabus has been approved by the BOS.

The part of Examinations for 2nd and 4th semesters were approved. New books and reference material, teaching methodologies were suggested. The next meeting was proposed to be held in August.
