MA Thesis: Historical significance of Vaikom in the history of Kerala

Vaikom is one such place, where evidences can be sited for all major practices of the respective times in Kerala; like Brahmadeya, pepper trade, rise and fall of ruling class, oligarchy of higher class, untouchability, unapproachability and the fight against it. The place witnessed the heroic struggle, the Vaikom Satyagraha which provided the basic right of freedom of movement to the lower classes which was denied for them for the plight of being a lower class. Much of the town's history is undocumented, the thesis have been focused on the history of VaikomMahadevar Temple, its tremendous influence on the inhabitants and the culmination of Vaikom Satyagraha.

BA project: Cultural history of Vaikom

Vaikom is a multi-religious land but it is known to be a "Temple City". VaikomMahadevar Temple has a documented history since past four hundred years and a much longer mythical history. Drawing parallels to other such places in the south like Madurai and Tanjavor, which has survived for a long period of time, the presence of cultural and economic epicenter usually plays a prominent role in its ability not just survive but thrive over time. And as with other Indian towns, such epicenter comes in the form of a temple that towers over all other architecture in the surrounding. Famous for the VaikathuAshtami, it is one of the few Temples which are held in reverence by both the Shaivaites and the Vaishnavaites. The project is an account to reveal the cultural history of Vaikom and its people.
