REVISED NOTIFICATION FOR UG ADMISSIONS 2020-21

Applications are invited for admission to the Undergraduate Programmes at St. Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam for the academic year 2020-21.

Admission to St. Teresa's College is not through the M.G. University CAP portal. Candidates should apply online through the Admission Portal in the College website only.

- The online admission portal for UG admissions is open from 10/07/2020.
- Applicants are requested to go through the Prospectus before applying to various programmes.
- The applicant must remit the application fee, of Rs.400/- for General candidates and Rs.200/- for SC/ST candidates, through online payment.
- Once all the required details in the application are filled in and submitted, a print out of the application must be taken, which has to be submitted to the college at the time of admission.
- Last date and time for applying online has been extended to 31/07/2020
- Candidates seeking admission to B.A. Bharatanatyam and B.Sc. Apparel and Fashion Design must apply online and also appear for an aptitude test, which will be conducted online on 01/08/2020.

Please note that candidates who have applied on or before 22/07/2020 will have the aptitude test on 25/07/2020.

(Details regarding the aptitude test for B.Sc. Apparel and Fashion Design and B.A. Bharatanatyam are given at the end of this notification)

- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APTITUDE TEST FOR B.Sc. APPAREL AND FASHION DESIGN

- An aptitude test will be conducted for the selection of candidates for admission to B.Sc. Apparel and Fashion Design
- The aptitude test will be conducted online
- The duration of the test will be one hour
- The test will be conducted online under the supervision of faculty members.
- The questions will be such that to test the drawing skills, selection of colour and colour combination and writing skills.
- The questions will be provided by the faculty members at the beginning of the live test
- The candidates must arrange a laptop with a good connectivity for the test.

The materials required for the test are: -

- A4 sheets
- Pencils (for drawing and shading)
- Colours (crayons or pencil colours)
- Eraser
- Sharpener
- Scale
- Ball point pen

The candidate after completing the test should take a clear image (one with a full view and second a close-up view of each section) and upload to the email id which will be provided along with the instructions of date and time of the test in the website.

If a student loses net connection in between the test, she would be required to attempt the test again with a new question.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APTITUDE TEST FOR B. A. BHARATANATYAM

- An aptitude test will be conducted for the selection of candidates for admission in B. A. Bharatanatyam.
- The aptitude test will be conducted online
- The duration of the test will be 30 minutes
- The test will be conducted online on a live platform under the supervision of faculty members
- The test will be about the basics of Bharatanatyam (Theory and Practical) and also about basics of Music and Rhythm
- Applicants should wear uniform (dance) sari or appropriate dress for dancing during the interview
- The candidates must arrange a laptop/mobile with a good connectivity for the test
- If a student loses net connection in between the test, she would be required to attempt the test again.
