ACTIVITIES

The activities of the arts club for the year 2020-21 were inaugurated on 22 March 2020 in the Platinum Jubilee Auditorium. Padma Bhushan Sree Mohanlal, Padma Bhushan Smt. The inaugural ceremony included speeches by the director Rev Dr. Sr. Vineetha and Principal Dr. Lizzy Mathew and the arts club report by the arts club secretary Ms. Anna Susan Roy.
