Minutes of the IQAC Meeting 22 June 2020

The newly constituted IQAC team of the College met at 11.00 a.m. with the Director, Principal and NAAC seven criteria heads for the 1st meeting of the IQAC for the academic year 2020-21.

The meeting began with a prayer and welcome address by Dr. Kala M. S., the new IQAC Coordinator. A presentation of the activities conducted during the lockdown period was shared with the Criteria Heads. The Director acknowledged the efforts of the IQAC team in attaining the 47th rank in NIRF and for conducting webinars for the faculty members.

The following agenda was discussed during the meeting:

Action plan for the year 2020 -21

- In an effort to equip faculty to effectively conduct online classes and evaluation, the IQAC suggested the conduct of Faculty Development Programs along these lines. A proposal was sent to the Teaching Learning Centre of IIT, Madras seeking collaboration.
- The Teaching Learning Centre of the College will be initiating more programs for students and faculty on effective use of MOODLE, online tools for assignments etc.
- Acknowledging the difficulties faced by students from economically backward category, IQAC initiated Project Sumanasu to raise funds and provide devices for students to access classes online. The details of the same were shared with all members.
- The IQAC and NAAC criteria heads will propose the budget allocation heads.
- Guidelines to create plan of Actions for Departments and Clubs will be drafted by the NAAC teams to align the year's activities with NAAC metrics.

Discussion on the New AQAR format

- The new format for AQAR was discussed. The IQAC will draft the AQAR form and share with the Department for data collection.
- The new format along with Standard Operating Procedures and Data Templates were shared with the respective Criteria heads.
- The NAAC teams will plan and implement action points. Each team will also foster a best practice.


