#### RELEVANCE OF THE COURSE

While introducing the evolution of feminist pedagogy it cuts across the traditional disciplinary boundaries, voice, authority and positionality.

- 4. Conduct research using feminist methodologies.
- 5. Use feminist frameworks to analyze the structure of gendered representations in media, language, and texts


