- **Dr. Sr. Teresa CSST** belongs to the Congregation of Carmelite Sisters of St. Teresa (CSST), Kerala Province. She is a retired **Principal of St. Teresa’s College, (Autonomous) ,** Ernakulam, Kochi. . She continued her service in the field of higher education as the **Principal of Sacred Heart Arts and Science College, Pondicherry.** She was awarded a Ph.D. in 2001, from Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala and has been appointed as the research guide in both M.G. University and Bharathiyar University in Coimbatore. She has specialized in Development Economics, Housing Economics, and Environment Economics. She continued her research further in the areas of HIV/AIDS in Kerala, and Municipal Solid Waste Treatment in Kerala and Women studies. **Two major projects were approved and funded by University Grants Commission, Delhi in 2004 and 2010 respectively for her post doctoral research work. She has authored TEN publications as books** and many research articles in refereed / peer reviewed journals to her credit. She is also a **member in many academic and professional bodies at the State and National level.** She is the **Peer Team Coordinator of National and Accreditation Council (NAAC Assessor), Bangalore.** Sr. Teresa CSST is appointed as the **Secretary General of Xavier Board of Higher Education in India ,** Bangalore on 15TH September 2021 and she completed the tenure of office as the Secretary General in 2024. She coordinated 420 Catholic Colleges across India on behalf of Xavier Board of Higher Education in India through various programs on Faith Formation, Gospel Leadership and Excellence and Quality of Teaching Learning in alignment with the Educational Reforms of the

contemporary time in the higher education scenario. Sr. Teresa was elected as the **CSST General Councillor for Education** on 24th April 2024 by the 18th CSST General Assembly held at Bangalore.
